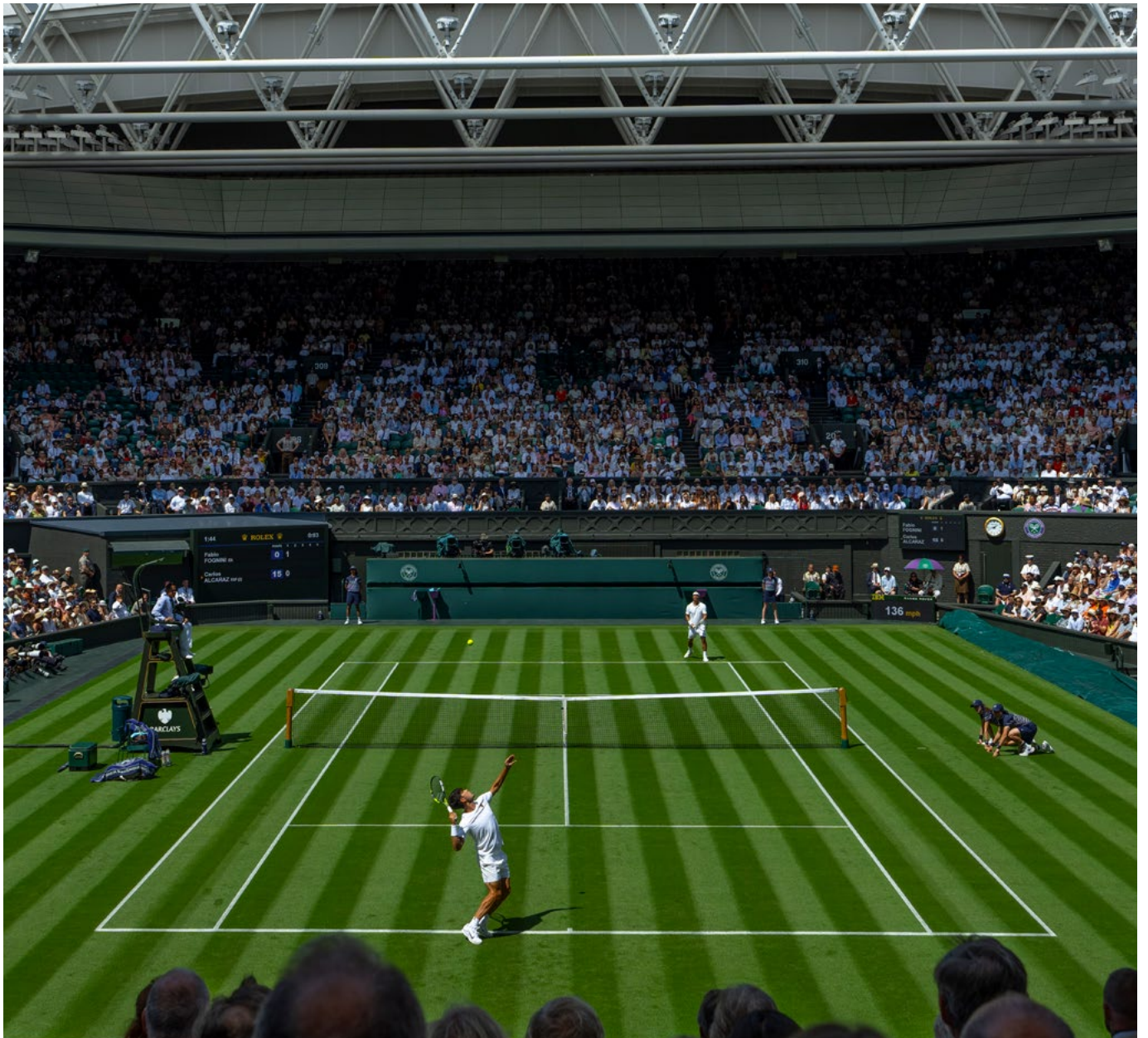

On behalf of everyone at The All England Lawn Tennis Club, I would like to extend you a warm welcome to The Championships 2026.

This handbook will provide you with all the information you need to make the most of your day, with further information on The Championships and our Grounds available on wimbledon.com, or via the Wimbledon App.

Maintaining Wimbledon's place at the pinnacle of sport is, of course, central to our ambitions and accordingly we have a range of improvements in store for 2026.

The No.1 Court debenture facilities have successfully undergone the first of a two-year renovation. The beautiful, newly refurbished Renshaw restaurant is complete, featuring a dining offer curated by Welsh chef Bryn Williams. We have further improvements in store for next year, focusing on the No.1 Court debenture casual dining spaces.

On court, earlier this year we announced the introduction of Video Review technology on six Show Courts, allowing players to review specific judgement calls by the Chair Umpire, and visual indicators will be installed on every court for live Electronic Line Calling to signal 'out' and 'fault' calls.

We will also celebrate a number of anniversaries, including 80 years since military service stewards first worked at The Championships and 50 years since wheelchair tennis originated as a competitive sport. Our learning programme and the Wimbledon Junior Tennis Initiative are both 25 years old, and they are part of our very considerable contribution to the local community as a force for good. From special moments on court to featured content on our channels, we will shine a spotlight on these anniversaries throughout the event.

I would like to end by sincerely thanking you for the wonderful support you give our Club and The Championships and I hope you enjoy a fantastic day with us at Wimbledon.

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BEFORE YOU VISIT



IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

Many of our guests choose to dress up for a day at Wimbledon, although there is no requirement for men to wear a jacket or tie in the debenture restaurants.

Please dress comfortably and come prepared for the British weather, whether that be rain or periods of warm sunshine.

WHAT SIZE BAG CAN I BRING WITH ME?

Pack everything you need in one bag per person measuring no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

WHICH GATE SHOULD I ARRIVE AT?

All debenture ticket holders are encouraged to use Gate 4 on Church Road.

WHAT DOES MY DEBENTURE TICKET INCLUDE?

Debenture tickets are valid for the court and date specified and entitle the ticket holder to access that court, rather than to view a particular match, round of matches or individual players. Matches may be moved between courts at the discretion of the AELTC. Full terms and conditions can be found [here](#).

You may also enjoy matches on courts throughout the Grounds with unreserved seating.

In addition to Centre Court and No.1 Court, No.2 Court also offers reserved seating. Unreserved seating is available on No.3 Court, Court 12, Court 18, and outside courts 4-11 and 14-17.

To watch players practising, visit the viewing platform next to the practice courts in [Aorangi](#).

Your Centre Court debenture ticket includes access to the Centre Court debenture bars and restaurants and The Renshaw restaurant located in No.1 Court (by reservation only).

Your No.1 Court debenture ticket includes access to the No.1 Court debenture bars and restaurants.

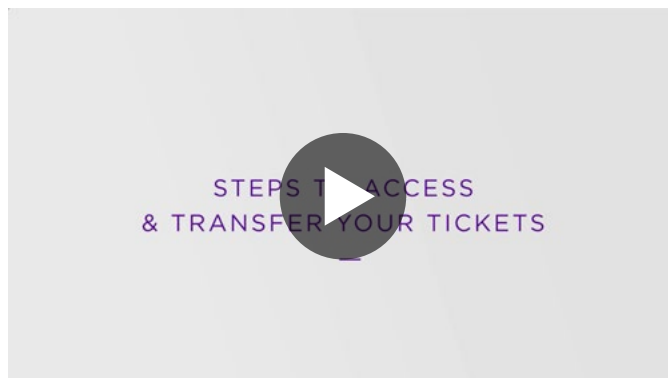
DO YOU TAKE CASH?

This is a cashless event, so please bring your credit/debit card or other form of cashless payment.

YOUR TICKETS

- Have your mobile ticket ready in the Wimbledon App along with photo ID for entry.
- The QR code on your mobile ticket will be active from 7am on the morning of the day you are attending.

HOW DO I ACCESS MY TICKET ON MY PHONE?



WHERE DO I GO IF I HAVE ISSUES WITH MY TICKET UPON ARRIVAL?

Please head to the Ticket Resolution Point at Gate 3 on Church Road if you have any issues with your debenture tickets.

WHERE ARE MY SEATS?

Debenture seats are located in rows A-N on Centre Court and rows A-Q on No.1 Court.

Your seat details will include a seat number, row and gangway. The gangway indicates the stairwell that you should use to access the court.

CAN I BRING CHILDREN?

Children aged five and over are welcome, provided they are accompanied by an adult at all times and have their own ticketed seat.

While we do not recommend bringing babies and infants, children under five do not require a ticket. However, children under five are not permitted on the Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18).



TRAVEL



To enhance the arrival experience for all guests, Church Road - the main road outside the Grounds - remains partially closed for the duration of The Championships.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The Championships Journey Planner is the easiest way to plan your journey, highlighting the most sustainable travel options to and from Wimbledon.

-  **Southfields Station** (District Line)
- 15 minute walk to the Grounds.
-  Taxis to the Grounds depart from the rank in Augustus Road, adjacent to the station, and drop off inside Car Park 8.
-  **Wimbledon Station** (District Line/South Western Railway/London Trams)
- 20 minute walk to the Grounds.
-  Taxis to the Grounds depart from the rank outside the station's main entrance and drop off at Marryat Road, near the junction with Somerset Road, close to Gates 12 and 13.
-  **Wimbledon Park Station** (District Line)
- 25 minute walk to the Grounds.

-  A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to the Grounds.
- Single fare £4.00
- Return fare £6.50

Return buses leave from Car Park 1 on Somerset Road.

Please note that during The Championships, the 493 TfL bus service is diverted in both directions via Bathgate Road, Queensmere Road, Parkside and High Street Wimbledon.

RIDE-SHARING APPS DROP-OFF

Ride-sharing services must use the designated drop-off areas located on Marryat Road and Wimbledon Park Road. Please note that cars from ride-sharing services, such as Uber and Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.



DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP LOCATION

Registered debenture holders can request a drop-off or pick-up (DOPU) pass, or both, if travelling by private taxi or chauffeur car to the Grounds, to gain access through the Church Road closure and be dropped off near Gate 4 (the debenture ticket holders' gate). **Please note, a DOPU does not entitle the holder to park.**

A DOPU can be requested by registered debenture holders throughout The Championships via wimbledon.com or through the Wimbledon App.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP ACCESS ROUTES

Drop-off (until 3.30pm):

- Drivers must approach the drop-off location from the south (from Wimbledon/ Wimbledon Village).
- The drop-off location is within Car Park 5, near to the Guest Arrival Hub.
- Drivers must exit via Car Park 8, north on to Wimbledon Park Road.
- Any drop-offs after 3.30pm must follow the pick-up route.

Pick-up (from 3.30pm):

- Drivers must approach the pick-up location from the north, via the Wimbledon Park Road entrance to Car Park 8.
- Access prior to 6.00pm is for immediate collection and departure, no waiting allowed.
- Strictly limited (maximum 30 minutes) waiting for guests is permitted after 6.00pm.
- The pick-up point is within Car Park 5, near to the Guest Arrival Hub.
- The exit is on to Church Road and cars can only turn left towards Wimbledon Village.

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE DROP-OFF

A drop-off point for Blue Badge holders is available opposite Gate 13 on Somerset Road.

If you would like to be dropped closer to the debenture entrance at Gate 4, please request a DOPU (as above). A buggy shuttle service operates, on request, from Car Park 5 and can transport you to a point opposite Gate 4.



CAR SERVICE

Gerrard Cars offers a transport service for debenture ticket holders travelling to and from The Championships.

The drop-off and pick-up point is located at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.

PARKING AT THE GROUNDS

- Parking for The Championships must be pre-booked, as on-the-day parking is not available.
- **Car Park 5** is available for registered debenture holders.
- **Car Park 6** is available for all ticket holders.
- Limited minibus parking is available in Car Park 6.
- Limited coach parking is available in **Car Park 1**.
- Motorcycle parking is available in Car Park 6.

Registered debenture holders can book parking by logging into their *myWimbledon* account via wimbledon.com or the Wimbledon App.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

- An area within Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders with Blue Badges.
- An area within Car Park 6 is available for all other Blue Badge holders.

ACCESSING THE GROUNDS FROM THE CAR PARKS

There is a short walk from Car Park 5, passing the Guest Arrival Hub for debenture and hospitality ticket holders, before crossing Church Road to Gate 4.

From Car Park 6 follow the signs to the Grounds and Gate 4.

LEAVING THE GROUNDS

For Wimbledon or the south, exit via Gate 12 on Somerset Road for:

- Shuttle bus service to Wimbledon Station (departing from Car Park 1).
- Shared taxi service.
- 20 minute walk to Wimbledon Station.

For Southfields and central London, exit via Gate 1 on Church Road for:

- Shared taxi service (located on Wimbledon Park Road).
- 15 minute walk to Southfields Station.

Ride-sharing pick-up

Pick-up points are located on Marryat Road and Wimbledon Park Road (opposite the taxi rank). Please note that cars from ride-sharing services, including Uber and Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.

Taxi pick-up

Shared taxi services with fixed fares operate from Southfields Station and Wimbledon Station:

- Return journeys to Southfields and central London depart from Wimbledon Park Road (exit via Gate 1).
- Return journeys to Wimbledon Station depart from Somerset Road taxi rank (exit via Gate 12).



AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS



CAN I MEET FRIENDS OR FAMILY BEFORE ENTERING THE GROUNDS?

The Guest Arrival Hub is available for debenture and No.1 Court hospitality guests. It offers a small seating area outside and toilet facilities inside, making it a convenient location to meet guests joining you for the day.

Debenture hosts will be available to answer any questions you may have.

The Guest Arrival Hub is located through the walkway opposite Gate 4, which we encourage all debenture ticket holders to use when entering the Grounds. View the map [here](#).



ONCE IN THE GROUNDS HOW DO I ACCESS THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

To access the debenture areas within Centre Court and No.1 Court, please show your mobile ticket. Your ticket will be scanned and you will be given a wristband to wear for the day. **We strongly recommend collecting your wristband upon arrival, before taking your seat to watch the tennis.**

WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION ONCE I'M IN THE GROUNDS?

Our team of debenture hosts, dressed in Ralph Lauren uniforms and wearing name badges, will be on hand to assist you throughout the day.

Hosts are located at the Debenture Information Point, situated to the left of the Fred Perry statue, which is visible upon entering Gate 4, as well as throughout the debenture areas. The Debenture Information Point is open daily from 10am – 2pm.



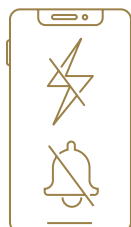


WHERE ARE THE CLOAKROOMS IN THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

- The Centre Court cloakroom is located on the ground floor inside the Fred Perry entrance.
- The No.1 Court cloakroom is located at the debenture reception, next to The Veranda restaurant entrance.
- Please bring any items you require in a bag no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

SPECTATOR ETIQUETTE

Remember to:



Switch your phone to silent around the courts and please ensure your flash is disabled.



Only enter or leave a court at the change of ends or between matches.



Refrain from bringing glasses or unopened bottles into the court stands.

If you are bringing children aged five and over, there are plenty of family activities to enjoy across the Grounds. Pick up a copy of 'Explore Wimbledon', our fun activity booklet, from the Wimbledon Foundation kiosk adjacent to Court 15. Visit the Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Museum, the world's largest tennis museum, or head to the Southern Village to test your skills across a range of exciting and interactive activations.



NEW FOR 2026

In line with our ambition to maintain Wimbledon's place at the pinnacle of sport, we have a range of enhancements in place for the 2026 edition of The Championships.

On court, earlier this year we announced the introduction of Video Review technology across six Show Courts, allowing players to review specific judgement calls made by the Chair Umpire. Visual indicators will also be installed on every court for live Electronic Line Calling to signal 'out' and 'fault' calls.

The second year of the Millennium Building project has now been successfully completed. This three-year project, due for full completion ahead of The Championships 2027, will provide state-of-the-art facilities for players, Members and the media. For 2026, significant improvements have been made to player areas, including a redeveloped performance zone featuring a larger gym, improved medical and physiotherapy spaces, a new recovery suite and nutrition bar. A new entrance atrium with open-plan seating has also been created, while the player lawn has been expanded to provide additional space for the players and their teams to enjoy when off court.

Around the Grounds, we have increased the provision of shade and shelter, giving guests more options during periods of high temperatures or inclement weather. Our public dining offering has also been enhanced with the evolution of the two-storey Centenary at the southern end of the Grounds. The Centenary Brasserie, on the ground floor, will continue to offer a traditional a la carte menu throughout the day, while the re-imagined Centenary Restaurant on the first floor will serve an array of small plates showcasing the finest British produce from land and sea.

The Official Poster for 2026, designed by British illustrator Nathalie Lees, is displayed throughout the Grounds and captures Centre Court as the symbolic and architectural heart of The Championships. The Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Museum's special exhibition 'A Slice of History', honours the rich culinary traditions of The Championships since 1877, with free entry for ticket holders.

In 2026, we will also celebrate a number of anniversaries, including 80 years since military service stewards first worked at The Championships and 50 years since wheelchair tennis originated as a competitive sport. Our Learning Programme and the Wimbledon Junior Tennis Initiative will both mark their 25th anniversaries, with activities taking place throughout the Fortnight to mark these milestones.

Environmental Sustainability

Wimbledon remains firmly committed to its Environment Positive goals and is taking action to reduce emissions and support nature. Our Official Water Partner for the last 17 years, evian, continues its commitment to reduce plastic packaging waste at The Championships and encourages guests to join the refill and reuse movement. Look out for their refill stations around the Grounds and in debenture areas.

We have measured the carbon weightings of all the food we serve taking into consideration the entire life cycle of ingredients within each dish. This is illustrated using a simple rating scale of A (very low emission) to E (very high emission). We want to make it easier for our guests to make climate conscious choices when they visit, as well as giving our chefs the ability to track and ultimately reduce the emissions associated with the food we serve.

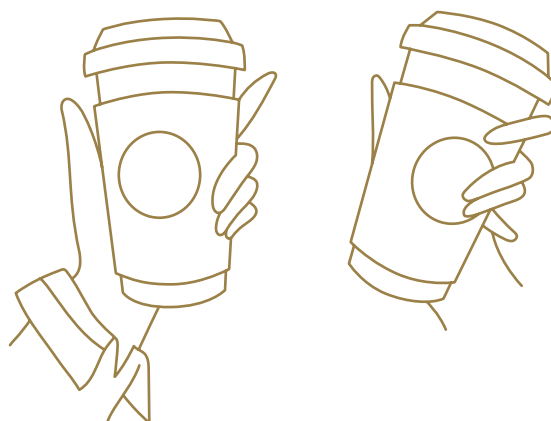


OPTIONS TO SUIT YOUR NEEDS THROUGHOUT THE DAY

Head to the Lavazza coffee bar located in The Gallery in Centre Court or the No.1 Bar in No.1 Court. The Roof Top bar in Centre Court also serves speciality coffees.



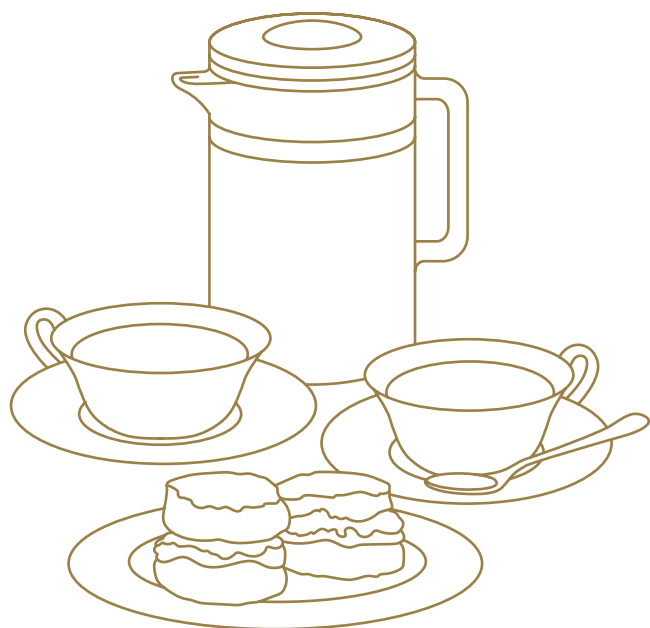
Enjoy a sit-down lunch before play begins.

The Courtside Brasserie in Centre Court and The Veranda in No.1 Court offer all-day menus. Alternatively, our self-service restaurants The Terrace in Centre Court, or The Lounge in No.1 Court, offer a wide range of hot and cold lunch options until 3pm.



Champagne and strawberries to take back to court.

If you're looking for both, we suggest heading to The Terrace if you're in Centre Court, or The Lounge if you're in No.1 Court. For takeaway drinks you can head to any of our bars.

A selection of cakes, scones with Wimbledon jam and Cornish clotted cream, tea and filter coffee are available in The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1 Court from 3pm. (On Finals Weekend from 2.30pm in The Terrace.)

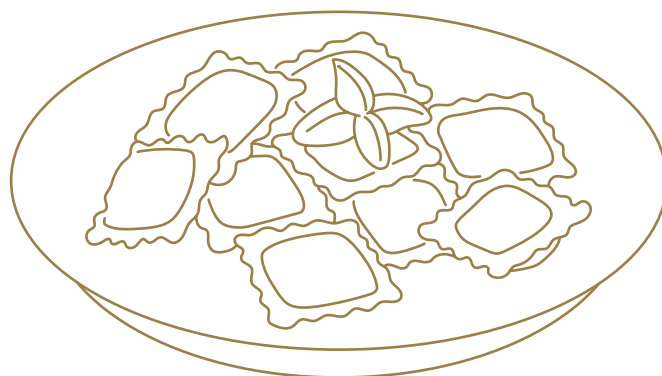
Walk-in guests are welcome for afternoon tea in the Courtside Restaurant, subject to availability. Service begins at 3pm, with last orders at 4.30pm. On Finals Weekend service begins at 2.30pm with last orders at 4pm.

A smaller selection is also available from our bars, alongside a selection of snacks.

Light supper menus are available from 4.30pm in The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1. Court, with last orders at 9.00pm.

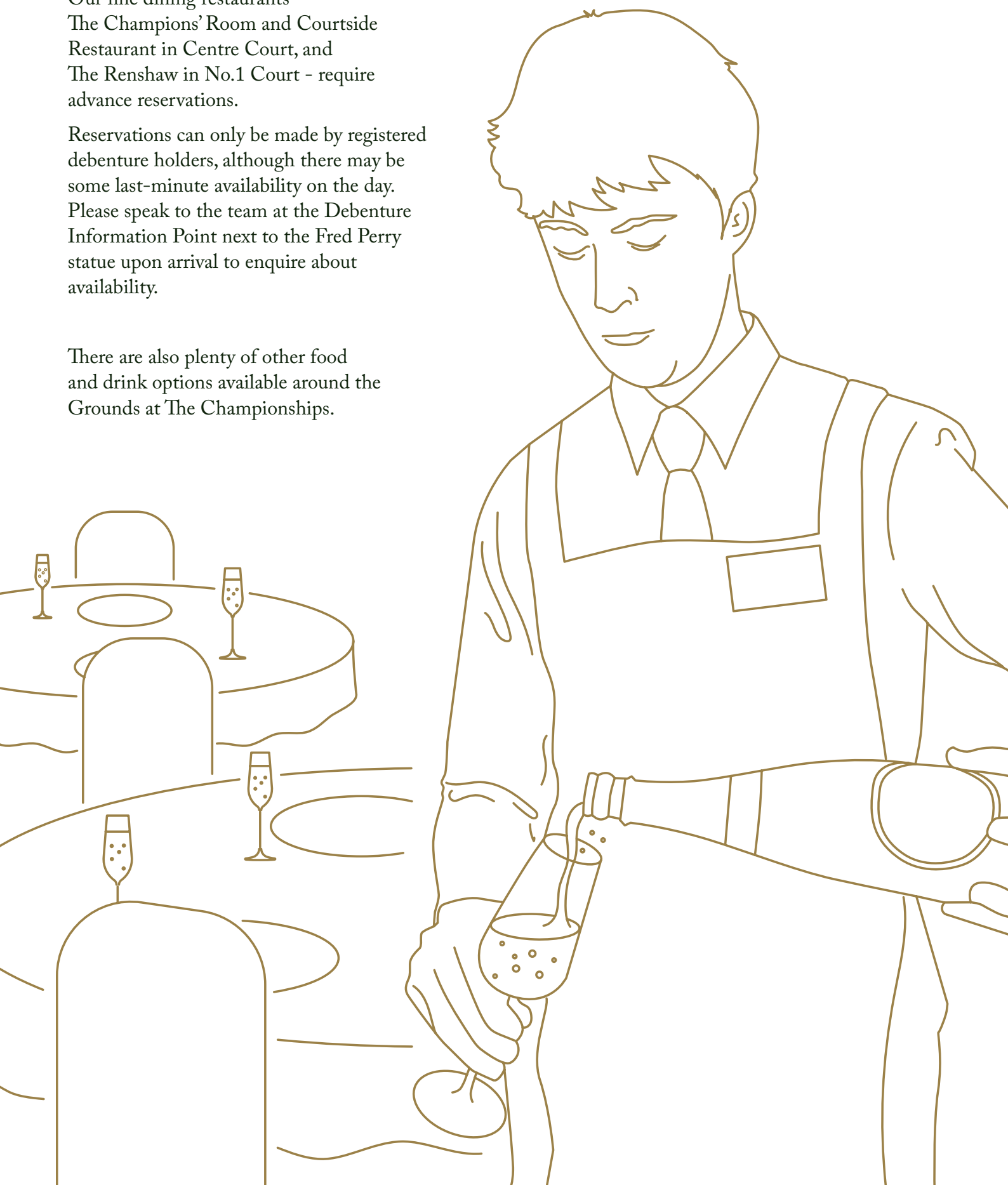
Our all-day menus in the Courtside Brasserie in Centre Court and The Veranda in No.1 Court have last orders at 7.30pm.

Our fine dining restaurants - The Champions' Room and Courtside Restaurant in Centre Court, and The Renshaw in No.1 Court - require advance reservations.

Reservations can only be made by registered debenture holders, although there may be some last-minute availability on the day. Please speak to the team at the Debenture Information Point next to the Fred Perry statue upon arrival to enquire about availability.

There are also plenty of other food and drink options available around the Grounds at The Championships.

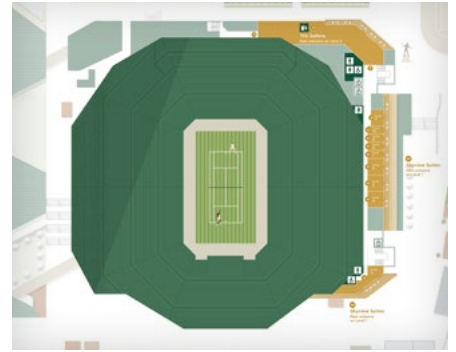
